# Being a Thelemite, and Being a Thelemite Who is an O.T.O. Initiate

A Thelemite (capital T) is, fundamentally, an adherent of Thelema, a religion (as most of us call it) whose essential principles are poetically set forth in *Liber AL vel Legis, Sub figura CCXX, the Book of the Law.* Many Thelemites accept the principles expressed in other writings into their understanding of Thelema, but this is largely a matter of personal preference. The community of Thelemites consists of every individual who has accepted the Law of Thelema and the *Book of the Law.* It is an extremely diverse, and extremely diffuse, community. The only thing they truly have in common is the *Book of the Law.* 

Members of O.T.O. constitute a well-defined subset of the community of Thelemites—and are likely a minority within that community. They are obligated to each other by fraternal bonds that do not apply to non-members, even non-member Thelemites. They are also obligated to abide by certain standards and principles of behavior, which include secrecy with respect to the particulars of O.T.O.'s initiation rituals.

In addition to *Liber AL*, O.T.O. membership entails recognition of a number of documents inherited from predecessor societies and developed specifically for O.T.O. by Theodor Reuss and Aleister Crowley. These can be found in *The Equinox Vol III, No. 1* (The Blue Equinox) and *Vol. III, No. 10*, and include *Liber XV, Ecclesiae Gnosticae Catholicae Canon Missae, the Gnostic Mass.* 

Another of these documents, the 1917 *Constitution of the Ancient Order of Oriental Templars* (O.T.O.) states the following (Article II):

1. The O.T.O. declares that Brotherhood of All Things Created is a fact in Nature.

2. The principle purpose of the O.T.O. is to teach True Brotherhood, and to make it a living power in the life of humanity.

Another of these documents, *Liber LXXVII: Oz*, sets forth a list of certain fundamental rights of Man, i.e., of humanity.

Several of the documents referred to above also state that O.T.O. is involved in teaching the principles of Hermetic Science and Yoga.

A Thelemite who is not an initiate of O.T.O. may or may not choose to recognize any of these principles, rights, or teachings.

### Those Who Walk Away

We recognize that O.T.O. membership may not be suited for everyone; and we also recognize that we sometimes fail to live up to our own high standards. There will always be those who decide, for a variety of reasons, to step away from participation in our worldly organization. It is important for us to allow them to go in peace. We must avoid retaliating, or engaging in any kind of harassment, against such people, simply over the fact that they walked away. Such behavior is characteristic of abusive cults, and it is unbecoming of O.T.O. membership.

- Passed mastership of ARARITA Oasis (San Diego, CA) from Sr. Amrita to Br. Jonah Hontos.
- Chartered William Blake Lodge (Baltimore, MD) as William Blake Oasis and passed mastership from Fr. FreeShadow to Br. Jeren.

- Extended the tenure of the masters of Circle of Stars Camp (Hanover, IN) and Mithras Oasis (Windham, CT) for one year.
- Suspended the charter of Heru Ra Ha Lodge (Newport Beach, CA) at the request of the master.
- Closed Swirling Star Lodge (Miami, FL) at the request of the master.

The Electoral College wishes to thank the outgoing masters for their years of service and to congratulate the new masters on the trust placed in them.

Procedurally, we extended the suspension of the dedicated lodge space requirement and the minimum number of Gnostic Masses requirement until January 1, 2024 EV.

Our Summer meeting will be held on July 9, 2022 EV in Oakland, CA. The deadline for submission of items to be considered is May 28, 2022 EV.

### WHY THE PRICE FOR LOVE IS PAIN Soror AVO

Do what thou wilt shall be the whole of the Law.

Years ago, I was sailing with some friends when out of nowhere, we encountered some rough seas. Joe called them "rogue waves." In our tiny 30-foot schooner, the 40-foot (think four stories high) waves looked more like giant mountains hurtling at us. I cinched the straps on my lifejacket a bit tighter and held on for dear life. But Old Joe as we called him was a seasoned captain, and he didn't even flinch. As any good sailor would do, he aimed the bow of the boat right at the center of the wave and kept an even keel, literally. One by one, we sailed over the waves and soon found our way back into calmer waters. The boat and its crew were intact, though I can't say the same for the lunch I ate prior to boarding.

In any case, I learned a few valuable life lessons that day, not the least of which was never forget your Dramamine. The more important lesson though was one that I've applied to every aspect of my life since then, and that is that no matter how rough things get, the only way through a problem is to face it headon. I have found this to be true with my work as a Thelemite as well. Taking initiations especially can bring up lots of crud that needs to get worked on.

Past traumas, bad habits, outmoded ways of thinking are all traps, like the blade edge of an iceberg just waiting to sink us. Personally speaking, there have been many times when something popped up and it didn't dawn on me until AFTER I struggled with it for a while, that it had anything to do with my growth spiritually. That is where, I think, the biggest risk of failure lies. We get so mired in the seeming mundaneness of the issues that creep up, that we forget that they are all part of the Great Work.

I like to think of the Great Work as a journey toward K&C or Union with one's Holy Guardian Angel, with each of the ten Sephirot as stopping points or places of reflection along the way. Sometimes we move up, sometimes we move down, sometimes we get completely lost. But every experience we have is part of that journey. How we meet each experience determines where we land next. Let's say for example that while driving to work, you get a flat tire. You call your boss to tell her you're going to be a few minutes late, and she gets mad and hangs up on you. Yikes. You have a few choices; you can (A) let the situation stress you out to the point where you quit your job and do a sloppy job fixing your tire, (B) fix your tire properly, but tell your boss to kiss your behind or (C) remain calm and tackle each problem as it comes, in the most appropriate manner you can think of. Each decision has its consequences. Here's the thing: in Thelema we say that "Love is the law, love under will." There are many layers of meaning to that. One of them is that when we approach things from an attitude of love, everything changes. Think of your own response if you were the boss and someone launched into your office screaming at you because you hung up on them, rather than if they knocked and said calmly, "Hey, are you OK? It's not like you to just hang up on someone." Love changes everything it connects with, and that is why the price for love is pain.

In Liber CL, Crowley writes: "...as love increaseth within you, so doth the torment of His absence." As you meet each challenge head on with love, you not only change yourself, but you draw ever closer to your HGA. If your HGA is the flame, love gives you the wings of the Moth. According to Crowley, the closer you get to your HGA, the further away you get from the material and mundane, until the mere existence in the world becomes a torment of

its own. The point here is that if your will is your ship, then love must be the rudder guiding you in the right direction. Without love, there is no progress. With love, the price of progress is change, and change as we all know can be painful.

So the next time you experience an obstacle or opportunity for change, remember that the pain of change is the price we pay for Love. You'll never find a better bargain.

### IN MEMORIAM

### James McLaughlin

I have been truly blessed to have known a host of exceptional people during my adult life. One of these people passed the veil into death over Christmas. That was James McLaughlin. I met James in my early 20s at an O.T.O. camping event in Austin called IO Pan Jam. We immediately became good friends. James was initiated by Grady McMurtry in the 1970s and brought with him a deep esoteric perspective. James was first initiated with Brother DuQuette, and I later found a book of Lon's inscribed to James with the message "together from day one." James had a clarity of vision without getting lost in the reeds that he was happy to share with those he worked with. He served as Master of Scarlet Woman Lodge for 8 years and focused on the Will of the community rather than a particular vision for what he wanted the community to be. He strove to be a servant leader. He also served as Most Wise Sovereign for Baphomet Chapter R+C, and he served for a time on the Supreme Grand Council of U.S. Grand Lodge.

I can honestly say that most of what I know about leadership came from James. He served as a deepsea diver in the Navy with three tours of Vietnam and later retired as a Sergeant Major from the Army. Only 0.8% of the enlisted Army ever makes it to Sergeant Major. He was also a Pathfinder, which is an elite unit in the Army that drops in behind enemy lines and marks out drop zones and landing zones for troops. For almost the entire time that I knew him, James was in terrific physical condition. He was frequently in the gym and had been bodybuilding since the 70s. He truly was exceptional, and he had a lot to teach to those lucky enough to be mentored by him.

James originally focused on the initiatory side of O.T.O. as E.G.C. wasn't his cup of tea. Later in his initiatory career James reversed course and dove deeply into the mysteries of E.G.C., becoming a supervising bishop for many clergy members in Texas and beyond. He truly shared his love through service.

James (or Jim as he liked to be called post-retirement) had a keen analytic mind and a deeply mystical spirit. His military training gave him a tendency to see things in a black or white frame. I felt blessed to give him counsel on several occasions. He used to say that I was good at seeing shades of grey and would call on me for context. I'm really going to miss those conversations. The last time I saw Jim I was startled at how frail he looked and how easily winded he had become. He looked me in the eyes and said, "it happens to all of us." Jim went into his last days with his eyes open and his head high. I hope that we can all live up to Jim's spirit and example. May his memory continue to inspire those of us lucky enough to have known him.
